Sealed bids will be received at Drexel City Hall, at the office of the City Clerk until 2:00 PM, September 21, 2009. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time in Drexel City Hall for:

SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT (SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOLS PROGRAM)

This contract includes the removal of existing sidewalks and incidental items. Construction of concrete sidewalks and ramps, traffic signage, storm sewer improvements, pedestrian crosswalks, grading, grass seeding, erosion control, and other incidental construction items necessary to complete the project.

All equipment, materials and workmanship must be in accordance with the drawings and specifications on file with the City of Drexel, Missouri.

Copies of the contract documents (Invitation to Bid, Instructions to Bidders, Bid Form, Bid Bond, Agreement Form, Performance Bond, Payment Bond, General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, Detailed Specifications and Drawings) desired for bidding purposes may be obtained at 8:00 AM, August 26, 2009 from the Engineer, *Bowers Engineering, Inc.*, 106 East Pearl, Harrisonville, Missouri 64701. The non-refundable price for each set of bidding documents is \$80.00 payable to the Engineer. A current plan holder list may be obtained from the Engineer. The plan holder list will be provided by mail or facsimile two days prior to bid date. No further information regarding plan holders will be provided by mail or telephone.

A certified check on a solvent bank or a bid bond by a satisfactory surety in an amount equal to 5% of the total amount of the bid must accompany each proposal as bid security, which may be retained by the Owner until the contract for the project shall have been awarded. Bid checks will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders within seven days after bid opening.

The bid check of the successful bidder shall be retained until satisfactory performance and payment bonds, in an amount equal to 100% of the contract, shall have been furnished.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the date of opening of bids.

"Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2004 Edition will be waived for this project."

All wages paid for work under this Contract shall comply with requirements of the Prevailing Wage Law of the State of Missouri, Missouri Public Law 294, Sec. 290.210 through Sec. 290.340, R.S.Mo. 1969, as amended.

The City of Drexel, Missouri, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Nondiscrimination in Employment: Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, Title VI and Section 3 of the 1968 HUD Act as pertaining to Equal Employment Opportunity through Affirmative Action. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Project Manual.

Tax Exempt Status: All or certain items required for this contract are for the constructing, repairing, or remodeling of facilities for an exempt entity and qualify for exemption from State and local sales and use taxes under R.S.Mo 144.062. The Instruction to Bidders and Regulations of the Contract include tax exemption provisions covering the submission of the application for tax exemption determination by the

Bidder awarded the Contract.
