Sealed bids for Forby Road Improvements Phase III Project, Federal Project STP-5401(668), will be received at 100 City Hall Drive, PO Box 125, Eureka, MO 63025-0125 until 10:00 A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on Tuesday, September 29, 2015 at Eureka City Hall, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a sealed envelope clearly marked "Forby Road Phase III Improvements Project STP-5401(668)".

The proposed work includes approximately 1,300 feet of Alt Road from Forby Road to the north and approximately 1,300 feet of Forby Road from just west of Alt Road to the east. Improvements include widening, sidewalk and drainage.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate) or State Wage Rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Eureka hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file seven (7) days prior to the bid opening.

Contractors and subcontractors who sign a contract to work on a public works project must provide a ten (10) hour OSHA Construction Safety Program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Eureka reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 14%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
