The Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Kansas City Regional Office (Department) received a closure plan in November 2012 and addendum on May 13, 2014 for the MDOT Dearborn Rest Area wastewater treatment facility under Missouri State Operating Permit (MSOP) MO-0129453.

**The closure plan (November 2012) and addendum dated May 13, 2014 is approved as submitted.** Please note that approval of the closure plan does not mean that the permit has been terminated. Termination is not finalized until all work has been completed and at least seventy percent of the disturbed area has been stabilized with established vegetation. Therefore, until termination of the permit is finalized, the permittee is responsible for meeting the requirements stated in the permit, such as submittal of the discharge monitoring reports and ensuring that permit renewals are submitted.

Once you have properly removed the wastewater treatment facility and have met the conditions for termination, then Form J, "*Request for Termination of a State Operating Permit*," must be submitted to formally terminate the permit.
