Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans for full-depth pavement replacement in the westbound lanes of Interstate 70 at St. Charles Road in Columbia.

Why is this work necessary?

The existing pavement has deteriorated to the point where replacement is necessary. The new surface will smooth the road and improve motorist safety.

How will traffic be affected?

It will be necessary to close the St. Charles Road overpass over I-70 for a total of 10 calendar days. During that time, one lane of westbound I-70 will be diverted up and over the exit and entrance ramps at the interchange. The eastbound exit and entrance ramps at St. Charles Road will remain open to provide access to the south side of I-70. Motorists will be detoured to either the 63 Connector or Route Z to access the north side of St. Charles Road and Lake of the Woods.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled for July or August of 2016.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

No.

What will the project cost?

The total project cost is approximately \$2 million.
