## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?**

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on planned improvements to the Route 50/63 and Shamrock/Liberty Road intersection near Jefferson City.

### **Why is this work necessary?**

To increase the safety of the intersection and reduce accidents.

### **How will traffic be affected?**

It will be necessary to close the intersection of Liberty Road with Route 50/63 and the intersection of Liberty Road with Shamrock Road during construction of the new intersection. Motorists will need to find alternate routes around the project. Short-term lane closures on Route 50/63 may be necessary during construction. The intersection improvements will be constructed in coordination with resurfacing of Route 50/63 from the Moreau River to the Osage River.

### **When will the work take place?**

The project is scheduled for summer of 2017.

### **Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?**

No.

### **What will the project cost?**

The total project cost is approximately \$430,000.
