



Safe & Sound Bridges In Mid-Missouri


The following shows the location of mid-Missouri bridges included in the Safe & Sound program.

Signs of Improvement

Safe & Sound signs are posted on all bridges included in the program to notify the public of bridges scheduled for improvement. Prior to the start of construction, signs displaying a brief description of the work as well as the completion season and year will be installed. Check the web site or call MoDOT to get the latest projected start dates for each bridge.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the Safe & Sound Bridge Improvement Program?

Safe & Sound will replace or rehabilitate 802 of MoDOT's most worn-out bridges in five years — by the end of 2013. Bridge improvements began in early 2009 and over 500 are already completed. MoDOT is completing 248 bridges using innovative contracting methods. The other 554 bridges are part of a \$487 million design/build contract with KTU Constructors. Bonds will be sold to pay for the bridge work, with annual payments of about \$50 million. MoDOT will use one-third of the federal bridge placement funds it receives annually to make payments.

2. How many bridges are included in the Safe & Sound program in the central Missouri area?

Eighty-seven bridges in the central Missouri area are included in the program. Tonight's meeting will focus on four bridges in Laclede County that are scheduled for construction during 2011 and 2012.

Route 32, Mill Creek Bridge, located west of Route U

Route N, Mill Creek Bridge, located one mile south of Route MM

Route Z, Walker Creek Bridge, located just south of Route 32

Route PP, Brush Creek Bridge, located two miles south of Route C

3. What type of improvements are planned for the bridges featured at tonight's meeting?

All four bridges will be completely replaced. Some temporary easements may be needed at some locations.

4. When will work take place?

Work on the Route PP Bridge over Brush Creek is scheduled to take place in fall 2011. Work on the remaining three bridges is scheduled to take place in 2012. Because construction crews across the state are moving from one bridge to another at an accelerated pace, construction schedules can change. The start dates will fluctuate as the contractor progresses from bridge to bridge. Check the Web site or call MoDOT to get the latest projected start dates for each bridge. 5. How will traffic be handled during construction?


To speed construction and save money, the bridges will close completely during construction and motorists will need to find alternate routes around the work area. Each bridge is expected to remain closed for anywhere between 44 and 54 days.


Laclede County, Route 32, Mill Creek Bridge

State route signed detour is Route Z, Route O, and Route AD.




Laclede County, Route PP, Brush Creek Bridge

State route signed detour is Route J, Route CC, and Route C.

Bridge Replacement. Closure duration is approximately 44 days.
State route signed detour is Route O, Route B, and Route 32.



Laclede County, Route N, Mill Creek Bridge

Bridge Replacement. Closure duration is approximately 44 days.
State route signed detour is Route MM, I-44, Route 5, and Route 32.
