



# U.S. 50 Proposed Sidewalk Improvements

Between Quincy Ave. & Massachusetts Ave. in Sedalia  
Public Meeting, June 22, 2011

## Frequently Asked Questions, Part 1

### **Q. What work is being proposed as part of this project?**

A. The project includes improving more than a half-mile section of sidewalk along each side of U.S. 50 from Quincy Avenue to Massachusetts Avenue. Portions of sidewalk will be replaced and improvements made to ensure Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards are met. The work is a part of a larger initiative by the Missouri Department of Transportation to systematically identify and correct sidewalk locations included in the state transportation system that are not currently ADA compliant.

### **Q. How will I know if sidewalk work will take place near my property?**

A. The displays used at tonight's meeting show the sidewalk locations that will be improved within the project area. MoDOT staff will be available tonight to answer questions about specific work that may be located near your property. ### **Q. When will work take place and how will traffic be handled during the work?**

A. The project will be completed between early and mid 2012. There will be times traffic lanes are restricted along U.S. 50 as work takes place on and near the sidewalks. Motorists should follow work zone signing and drive through this area with care.

### **Q. What is the project cost?**

A. Work will cost about \$286,000.



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## Frequently Asked Questions, Part 2

**Q. Will trees, shrubs and fencing located along the sidewalk be affected by the improvement?**

A. During the sidewalk improvement work, measures will be taken to minimize the impact to trees, shrubs and/or fencing located adjacent to the sidewalk. No additional right of way or easements are needed to complete this work, however, there may be some items located on the right of way that could be affected in order to ensure the completed sidewalk is constructed at the proper slope and is clear from any obstructions. Additionally, areas of sidewalk leading to the roadway that are located between the sidewalk and the roadway may be removed, as curb parking is not permitted along U.S. 50.

**Q. Will work limit access to my driveway?**

A. There are some areas of sidewalk located across driveways that will be improved. As this work takes place, access to individual driveways may not be available for short durations. Construction crews will work with property owners as driveway work takes place.

**Q. Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?**

A. No right of way or easements are needed for this project. Work will take place on state right of way.
