

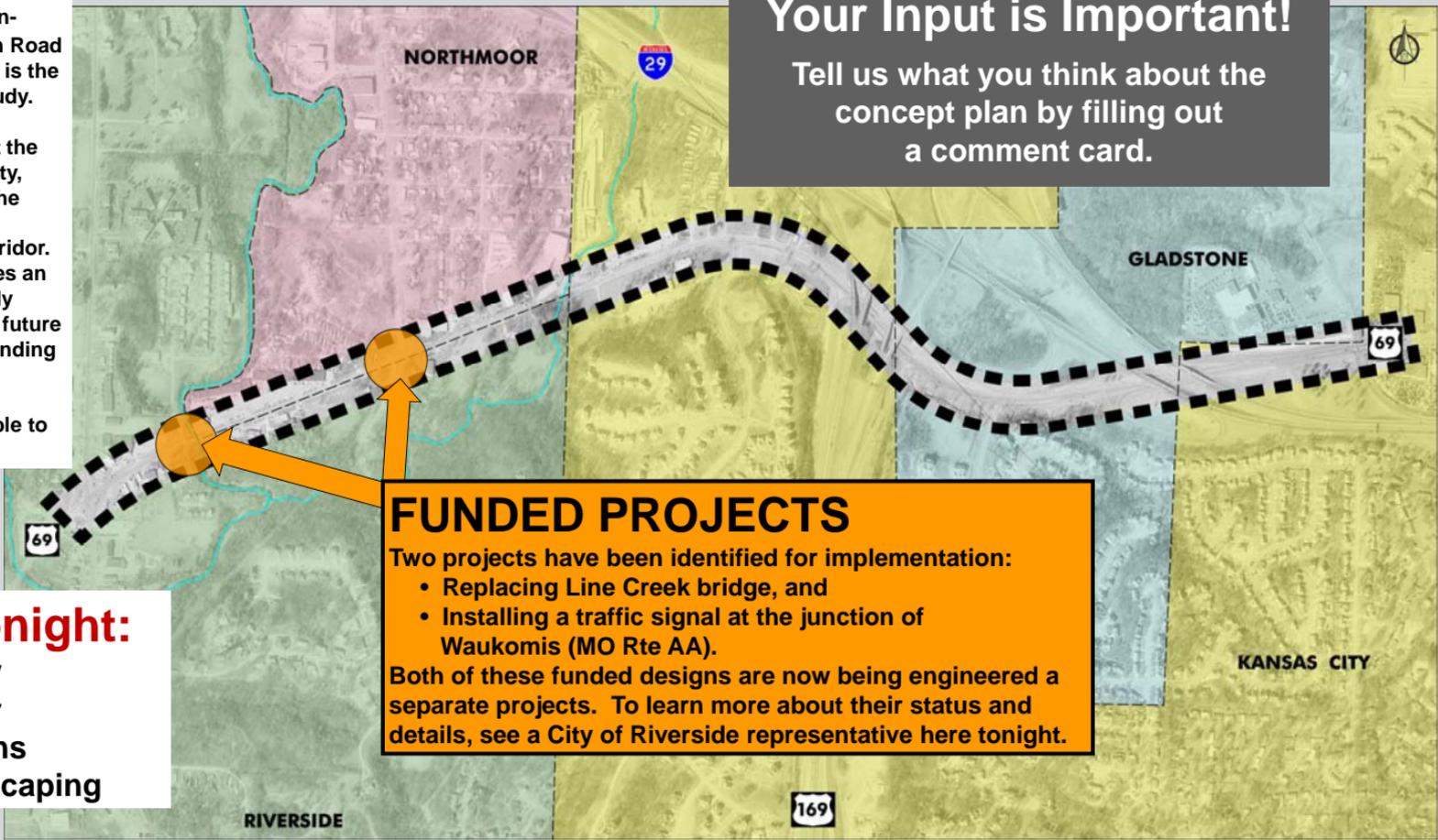

The study is a cooperative effort amongst the Cities of Riverside, Northmoor, Kansas City, Gladstone and MoDOT.
