

Hi. This is Sally Oxenhandler with your MoDOT Minute.

MoDOT has implemented variable speed limits along Interstate 270 to help keep traffic flowing better during peak congestion. If congestion is slowing travel, MoDOT will lower the speed limit. If travel times are shorter, the speed limit will increase. Motorists are made aware of the changes through electronic road signs.
