



Missouri River Flood of 2011

Updates on Closed Roads in Missouri

November 14, 2011

Interstate 29 NOW OPEN

- Interstate 29 opened on Saturday, October 8th.

US 136, Atchison County NOW OPEN

- The road reopened to traffic on Tuesday, October 25th.

US 159, Holt County (Closed from Route P to the Nebraska State Line)

- An Emergency Contract was awarded September 30th to Ideker, Inc.
- Work started October 19th to fill the easternmost scour hole. Operations will continue seven days a week until the scour areas are filled. To date, 51,797 tons of rock has been placed in the easternmost scour hole.
- The entire emergency repair contract has a projected completion before December 15, 2011. This will not include full depth paving or resurfacing. That work will be part of a later repair contract.

US 59, Buchanan County NOW OPEN

- The road reopened to traffic on September 28th
